Application Requirements

Part 1 –

All applicants must complete and meet the below requirements before moving onto Part 2 of the application process.
Please note: Satisfying the below requirements does not guarantee a space in the EPUT program.

- Attend an Electric Power Utility Technology Program information session - www.bhcc.edu/admissions/info/**
- Complete the BHCC application online at www.bhcc.edu/admissions/applynow.**
- Submit proof of high school completion (or its equivalency) by uploading the document to your online application through BHCCAdmissions or emailing a copy to selectiveadmissions@bhcc.edu.**
 - A copy of your final high school transcript or diploma
 - A copy of your passing GED or HISET score report
- Complete Foundations of Algebra with a grade of C or higher** (BHCC's course is MAT 097) or take the College Placement Test (CPT) and place into **Intermediate Algebra** (BHCC's course is MAT 099).
- Complete Writing Skills II with a grade of C or higher** (BHCC's course is ENG 095) or take the College Placement Test (CPT) and place into **College Writing I** (BHCC's course is ENG 111).
- Review additional placement options to satisfy the above requirements, visit the [Assessment Center](#).
 - If you have previously attended another college or university, BHCC will evaluate successfully completed courses to see if you are exempt from testing. To review prior course work options click [here](#).
