Transfer Articulation Agreement between Bunker Hill Community College and Lesley University for the Associate of Arts degree in Business to the Bachelor of Science degree in Business Management.

Date Established: Spring 2012, Updated Spring 2021

Eligibility:

1. Students must complete the Associate of Arts degree in Business or Associate of Science Degree in Management at BHCC with a minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher.
2. Students will be admitted to Lesley with full advanced standing (a minimum of 60 semester credit hours of transfer credit and a maximum of 90 credits).
3. All passing grades will be accepted for students who have completed an Associate's Degree.
4. Students who have completed an Associate's Degree will have completed the Lesley General Education Foundation with the exception of the General Education Capstone course.
