- 1. Students must complete the Associate of Arts degree in Early Childhood Development at BHCC with a minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 2. Students will be admitted to Lesley with full advanced standing (a minimum of 60 semester credit hours of transfer credit and a maximum of 90 credits).
- 3. All passing grades will be accepted for students who have completed an Associate's Degree.
- 4. Students who have completed an Associate's Degree will have completed the Lesley General Education Foundation with the exception of the General Education Capstone course.
