Articulation Agreement Transfer Guide

Transfer Articulation Agreement between Bunker Hill Community College and the University of Massachusetts, Boston for the Associate of Science degree in Nursing to the Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing (online).

Date Established: Spring 2020, updated Spring 2024

Eligibility: Students admitted to the BHCC ADN program and opt-in to the RN to BSN Transfer Agreement are eligible for admission to the RN-BSN program at the University of Massachusetts, Boston. Acceptance to the RN-BSN program is contingent upon the following:

- A. Successful completion of the BHCC ADN program as evidenced by an official transcript reflecting a conferred ADN degree.
- B. Successfully passed the NCLEX-RN and be licensed as a Registered Nurse in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
- C. Completed Student Authorization for Temporary Release of Information form to allow BHCC to disclose directory-student information to UMB to determine eligibility for enrollment in the program.
- D. Enroll in the UMB BSN program within one year of completion of the BHCC ADN program.

Students do not need to pay the UMB application fee or submit an application essay.
