Students apply to specific Health pathway programs after Semester Two. Once admitted into a program, students will switch to their specific health program.

The AA Health Sciences program also satisfies all General Education requirements and the MassTransfer General Education Foundation. Students completing this associate's degree are qualified to apply for baccalaureate level health programs such as nursing, nutrition science or programs outside of health sciences.
