



GREEN BUILDING
COUNCIL



There are four levels of LEED certification.



We anticipate that the Health and Wellness Center will receive a **LEED GOLD** rating.

PLATINUM

52-69 points

GOLD

39-51 points

The state of Massachusetts requires a minimum of a **LEED CERTIFIED** rating

for new buildings.

SILVER

CERTIFIED



33-38 points

26-32 points






Greenhouse Gas Inventory Report




